

## PCCW Meeting Minutes

Preparations for **Easter Breakfast** will take place on April 20<sup>th</sup> at 1pm. Help will be needed after Easter Breakfast to pick up items off tables to prepare for rummage sale set-up.

A motion was also made to **thank Mike and Phil** with a \$50 gift certificate to Fat Daddy's. Vote taken, motion passed. Sister Charlotte provided an update on **Project Connect**.
