

PCCW Meeting Minutes

December 8, 2017 *

Opening

The regular meeting of the PCCW was called to order at 10:15 a.m. on December 8, 2017. 15 members were present. Gardis acted as Secretary as Barbara was out of town.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes of the November 10th meeting were read by Gardis and approved with one addition: Books also went to CAM.

Financial Report: Marilyn reviewed the December 6th financial report. Pam reported on items currently listed on Ebay. No results but will continue to monitor.

Report of Officers: President: Kathy reported she received a call from Delmina Woods regarding our donation to their Silent Auction. They expressed interest in the Angel donation but did not follow through to pick it up. Pam suggested Beanie Babies go into Silent Auction.

Vice President: Nancy discussed plans for the December 8th PCCW party and Jan 25th Soup Supper. Nancy Loughner will oversee Soup Supper and there will be sign- up sheets.

Parish Council Report: No Report

Unfinished Business: Sister reported Ann is making good progress. John Loughner's sister passed away. His mother is 91 and living in a nursing home. Keep them in your prayers. Sister thanked us for the money to the Parish. \$3900 was deposited.

Kitchen Needs: Six mats were purchased. One more 72-inch mat is needed and will cost around \$80. Asked what other items were needed. Nancy T requested a pie cutter that costs under \$10. A motion was made to purchase the mat and pie cutter, and the motion passed.

The November sale of crafts at the Knights' Breakfast totaled \$81.50. The total net proceeds of the craft fair totaled \$1077.38. The Community Thanksgiving Dinner served 205 people. The Cookie Sale at the Methodist Church made \$1550.00. Janet sent thank you cards to each Church that participated. Janet mentioned that if anyone had a cookie press, we could maybe make spritz cookies for the next sale because they would sell well.

The men will choose a charity to donate \$500 from the rummage sale. They haven't agreed on a charity yet.

New Business:

Marilyn suggested we donate the money we put in reserve (\$400) for the December 10th breakfast to the Knights, so parishioners can still eat free. After a short discussion, a motion was made and approved.

Trudy reported Forsyth Elementary was in need of under garments and sweat pants. She and Karen purchased. The Parish Potluck Christmas Party will be on December 17th at 2 p.m. Sister Charlotte, Kathy, and Nancy T will plan. The hall will be decorated on December 15th after mass. All three priests will attend. Three extra gifts will be acquired.

Funeral Committee for Dec 8 through March 9, 2018 are Gardis, Dorothy and Jan.

The next PCCW event is the Soup Supper January 25, 2018. Nancy L will coordinate. Guests may come early to play games prior to the soup supper. Church directory will be ready in March. The 8 X 10 photos will arrive prior to Christmas. The church will be decorated for Christmas on December 20th after mass. Janet and Gardis will put up the nativity in the gathering space.

Our PCCW Christmas Party will be held at Wagon Wheel following adjournment of this meeting.
