

PCCW Meeting Minutes

January 10, 2020

Opening- The regular meeting of the PCCW was called to order at 10:00a.m.on January 10, 2020. Eleven (11) members were present.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes of the December meeting were read and approved.

Financial Report: Marilyn Guy reviewed the financial report. Barbara Peterson reviewed the estimate received from Zanescape and the new estimate from Opie's Landscaping for \$6850.00 (see attached) which included hardscaping with boulders, rock and mulch along with building berms and planting shrubs and plants. Zanescape's estimate did not include additional boulders or berms. A motion was made to approve \$5000 for the sign landscape project with Opie's Landscaping. Vote taken, motion passed. Barbara Peterson will follow-up with Opies Landscaping.

Report of Officers: President: Kathy Strader shared correspondence received from various organizations. We received donation requests from the Boys and Girls Club and Kids Across America. A motion was made to donate \$250 to the Boys and Girls Club in Forsyth.

Vice President: Nancy Thomas provided an update on up-coming events: Jan 15th take down Christmas decorations in Hall. Sister Charlotte suggested the Nativity be taken down after Mass on Jan 12th as we will have the manpower, Jan 23rd Soup Supper, Jan 26th 60th Wedding Anniversary Brunch for the Kruegers.

Parish Council Report: Sister Charlotte shared the meeting agenda as the next meeting is scheduled for Feb 12th. The Agenda includes: AED Unit, Safety Plan, Results of Parish Survey, Budgeting for HVAC Units & Picture Directory. Sister also asked for volunteers to call parishioners who have not been at church for a while.

Unfinished Business: We purchased a Bunn Coffee warmer for 2 pots and 2 kitchen towel racks. We discussed the Christmas Parties and received favorable comments. It was suggested that the older children be included in the gift exchange and we provide gifts for the smaller children. The Cookie Walk raised \$1756.50 for Taney County Ministries.

New Business: The Anniversary Brunch for the Kruegers will be held on January 26th. Set-up and food preparation will take place on Saturday the 25th starting at 9:00a.m. Nancy Loughner discussed rummage sale needs stating that we may need a fourth storage unit depending on in-coming donations. We discussed concerns about how many donations we could handle because of the limited number of parishioners that can help with set up as well as the limited space we have to display items. No vote was taken on an additional storage unit at this time. Nancy Loughner will put an article in the bulletin asking parishioners to hold items until the sale. We will start setting up after Easter. Nancy also requested ideas for charity organizations that could benefit from the Men's donation that she can pass onto the men. Kathy & Barbara shared ideas for silent auction baskets and if anyone wishes to donate items, they may do so at any time. It is scheduled for March 15th along with our St. Patrick's Day Dinner. This is the year to elect new officers for PCCW. Nancy Loughner volunteered to write a brief article for the bulletin and Darlene Bissell volunteered to be the contact person. Nancy Loughner discussed the up-coming Soup Supper. Set up will be Wednesday, Jan 22nd after coffee and doughnuts. The Left-Right-Center game will start at 3:30p.m. Invite friends, cost is \$5 plus a canned item. Cashiers are: 4-4:30 Fran, 4:30 -5 Marilyn, 5-5:30 Kathy. A suggestion was made to move meetings from Fridays to Wednesdays. This may facilitate more women attending and allow others to consider becoming an officer. Tabled for discussion at a future meeting.
