

## PCCW Meeting Minutes

**March 8, 2019**

### **Opening**

The regular meeting of the PCCW was called to order at 10:00 a.m. on March 8, 2019. Thirteen (13) members were present.

**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes of the February meeting were read and approved.

**Financial Report:** Marilyn Guy reviewed the financial report and reported a deposit of \$1000 was made to PCCW . This was a donation made by the family of Carol Haraf. We are currently paying for three storage units and will give one up at the end of April.

Suggestions were made for flowers, chocolates and Masses. Kathy asked if the PCCW wanted to continue meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of the month. All were in favor of staying with the current schedule. Kathy extended an invitation from the Forsyth Library to their upcoming Potato Bake and Raffle Fundraiser.

**Vice President:** Nancy Thomas reviewed the upcoming calendar of events which included: St. Patrick's Day Dinner and Silent Auction –March 17<sup>th</sup>, The Women's Retreat on April 6<sup>th</sup>, Rummage Sale Meeting after Mass on April 10<sup>th</sup> and the April 12<sup>th</sup> clean-up of the kitchen has been postponed until after the rummage sale in May

**Parish Council Report:** The new billboard is up on Hwy 160 and we received the new safe.

**Unfinished Business:** DCCW Spring Assembly-Nancy Thomas and Gardis Ohlson will represent us at the Assembly. A motion was made to approve \$215 to cover expenses: \$115 for hotel room and \$100 registration fee. Vote taken, motion passed. We will be donating a purse for the purse auction.

**New Business:** Fr. Dave will be hosting the Project Connect planning meeting at our church on April 4<sup>th</sup> and we have been asked to host the luncheon. A motion was made to designate \$150 towards providing a lunch, vote taken, motion passed. The following members volunteered to make a homemade dessert for the luncheon: Dorothy – Brownies, Gardis O -Cupcakes, Nancy T- Pie, Janet M –Pie. Thank you Ladies.

Spring cleaning for the church has been changed to Wednesday, April 10<sup>th</sup> after the Rummage Sale Meeting. We will need cleaning items such as dusting cloths and hand held vacuum cleaners for the pews.

The Lenten Women's Retreat is scheduled for April 6<sup>th</sup>. Kathy discussed talking to Sister about a date change since many will be out of town that weekend. The theme is "Compassion" and asked those attending to bring a heart item that has significance and meaning to you. A sign-up sheet was passed around.
