

PCCW Meeting Minutes

May 16, 2019

Opening-The regular meeting of the PCCW was called to order at 6:30pm on May 16, 2019. Eleven (11) members were present.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

Financial Report: Marilyn Guy reviewed the financial report.

Report of Officers: President: Kathy shared updates and ideas from other PCCW groups on meetings and providing a simple soup supper prior to Stations of the Cross to encourage attendance.

Vice President: The up-coming calendar of events was reviewed by Nancy: Knights of Columbus Steak Dinner on May 19th. Silvis 50th Wedding Anniversary Brunch –May 26th after Mass. Remaining monies (\$385) from the Mother's Day flower collection will go towards new rose bushes as some are not doing well. Kathy reviewed the saying for the memorial stake for Fr. Phil's tree. She will obtain a sample. The envelope holders for the pew will cost around \$400 and more research will be done.

New Business: A new freezer was donated to the church. The \$125 donation from Patt Strom was spent on purchasing needed items for the kitchen per Patt's request. Desserts are needed for the Knights Steak Dinner. Proceeds will go towards the purchase of a defibrillator. Barbara Peterson is coordinating the anniversary brunch for the Jake and Toni Silvis, she reviewed the menu and asked for help on Saturday, May 25th to decorate and prep items. Several volunteered. Friday, May 31st has been scheduled for kitchen clean up. All help is needed. The Knights are providing donuts and coffee on Father's Day. A discussion was held regarding a gift for the men from the PCCW. A motion was made to purchase Mini LED Flashlight Keychains. Vote taken, motion passed. The first meeting of the Crafty Crew will be held on July 17th after Mass. Please send ideas to Kathy and a work day will be scheduled for August.

Marilyn passed out the proposed budget, after discussion review a motion was made to approve budget. Vote taken motion passed. The \$300 for the men’s charity was placed on hold so a charity could be chosen.
