

PCCW Meeting Minutes

October 6, 2017

Opening

The regular meeting of the PCCW was called to order at 10:10am on October 6, 2017. 14 members were present.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes of the previous meeting (September, 2017) were read. One correction was made to the amount approved for Craft Supplies. \$150 was approved for craft supplies for the upcoming Craft Fair. Minutes were corrected and approved.

Financial Report: The Financial Report was tabled for discussion later in the meeting to discuss budget and distribution of Rummage Sale proceeds. \$25 Gift Card to “Michaels” for Sister Charlotte was approved. Call for any outstanding receipts. Receipts for the purchase of new Hose Reels and the receipt for the Rummage Sale Ad to run in the Taney Times were turned in to Marilyn.

Report of Officers: President: Kathy reported the PCCW publication “Connections” Magazine did not print our entire report for the month of September. Our entire report was read. A big “Thank You” went out to all craft day workers. Kathy reported the wheel chairs purchased by PCCW were being utilized by church member

Vice President: Nancy reported on schedule of events for the upcoming rummage sale. The Oct 6 outing to Cedar Creek has been cancelled. Oct 11th rummage sale meeting and removal of table center pieces. Oct 13th, rummage sale set up begins with lunch provided. Oct 16 rummage sale items can be brought in by members.

Parish Council Report: Sister Charlotte reported Fr. Dave has asked the current council to stay on. Phil Harter is the Chairperson and Kevin Hutchinson is the Chairperson in training. Council members are requesting input for the church sign.

Unfinished Business: *Emmaus Room*-the new chairs are ready to be shipped. *Parish Picnic*-Comments regarding the parish picnic were made: fun, enjoyed, more attendance needed, every child from the Parish came at one time or another. Fr Dave did a great job calling bingo. Dice game was good. Real community bonding time. *National Child Safety Council*- Motion made to approve \$62.50 for the child safety program. Vote taken and approved.

New Business: *Bible Donation* – will continue. *Numana Project* –Sr. Charlotte reported the Presbyterian Church was seeking volunteers to package food as part of the “Numana Project” and/or a monetary donation for a box of food which would cost \$64.00. A motion was made to purchase a box of food for \$64.00. Vote taken and approved.

Ecumenical Cookie Sale at Methodist Church –Janet will chair the cookie sale for OLOTO. Fran and Gardis will also help with the cookie sale.

PCCW Christmas Party - The PCCW Christmas Party with gift exchange will be held on December 8th after the meeting. All women from the Parish are invited to join. A motion was made to have the party at the Wagon Wheel and the tab to be picked up by the PCCW. Vote taken and motion carried. ***Mass of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick*** will be held on December 10th. A casserole breakfast will be served after this mass. A free-will offering will be accepted. ***Parish Christmas Party*** – The Parish Christmas Party is scheduled for December 17th. The planning committee are Kathy S, Nancy T and Sr. Charlotte. ***Craft Show***-Kathy presented the “Country Store” banner we ordered for our booth at the craft fair. Janet and Gardis will set up. ***Community Thanksgiving Day Dinner*** – The community will be hosting a dinner for those that will be alone on Thanksgiving Day from 12 -3pm. Various churches, the Elks and Lions Club are participating. Phil Harter is the contact person for OLOTO and we have been asked to assist in food preparation. There will be a sign-up sheet along with information in the bulletin. Five (5) persons are needed from 7-9am and 9-11am to assist in preparing the food. Carry-outs for homebound will be available.

Rummage Sale – The Rummage Sale meeting will be held on Oct 11th after the 9:00am mass. Arrangements have been made for the leftover items. They will go to Forsyth Library Thrift Store, paperback books to CAM, warm clothing to Jesus Was Homeless, few “gift items” to Taneyville School for their Christmas Store and Church Army to take everything else. Flyers are ready for distribution. Nancy T has started setting up lunches and Carl will prepare breakfast during set up days. There will be a sign-up sheet for daily kitchen clean-up.

Discussion of Organizations and Charities supported by the rummage sale will be held after the sale along with disbursement of monies. PCCW Christmas Party, Casey’s Gift Cards and Silent Auction Gift Cards were added to the budget list. The following suggestions were made: \$175 for Bibles, \$100 for Ladies Retreat and \$75 for PSR.

Adjournment: the Meeting adjourned at 12:00pm with prayer. The next meeting of the PCCW will be held on November10, 2017.
